Auditions for entry this September take place on Saturday, 4th September. **It is possible to accept applications up to 1st September.** Application Forms can be downloaded from the London Junior Ballet website.

To apply, present students (and new students offered a place starting in September) should have been placed in the Senior level class, or have passed an Intermediate examination and have reached their 14th birthday by 31st August. The maximum age for entry is 16.
