## SCHOLARSHIP TERMS AND CONDITIONS

**The scholarship audition will take place on SATURDAY 4 SEPTEMBER from 13:00 – 14:30. There will be a warm-up class for those who did not audition in the morning, at 12.30.**

1. London Senior Ballet will be giving two full scholarships for students aged 14+ for the academic year 2010 - 2011. The adjudicator is also able to split a scholarship between two or more students. These scholarships are funded by London Senior Ballet and are intended for students who will be going into full time training at 16+.
2. They are open to present students and to those who have auditioned and been accepted and will be awarded on ability only.
3. To apply, students should have been placed in the Graduate level class for next year, or have passed an Intermediate examination and have reached their 14th birthday by 31st August. **The maximum age for entry is 17.** For students joining LSB for the first time the same age limits apply and they must have auditioned and been accepted and have passed an Intermediate examination or been offered a place in the Graduate Class. (Those students auditioning for a place on the programme on the morning of 1st September will be told at the end of their audition if they are eligible to go on to the scholarship audition).
4. The scholarships are for students who do a full day at London Senior Ballet and will cover Pilates, Ballet and Pointe work. **Only those who are intending to do a full day should audition.**
5. The scholarships are worth approximately £900 each and students accepting them will be required to make a firm commitment for the year. The only acceptable excuses for missing classes would be illness or an audition for full time training. The scholarship may be withdrawn if classes were missed for any other reason and the student would then become liable for full fees for the remainder of the term. Full fees would also be charged if a student left without giving proper notice.
6. The scholarship audition will take the form of a ballet class. LSB will always engage an external adjudicator.
7. Students must have the permission of their ballet school to apply.
